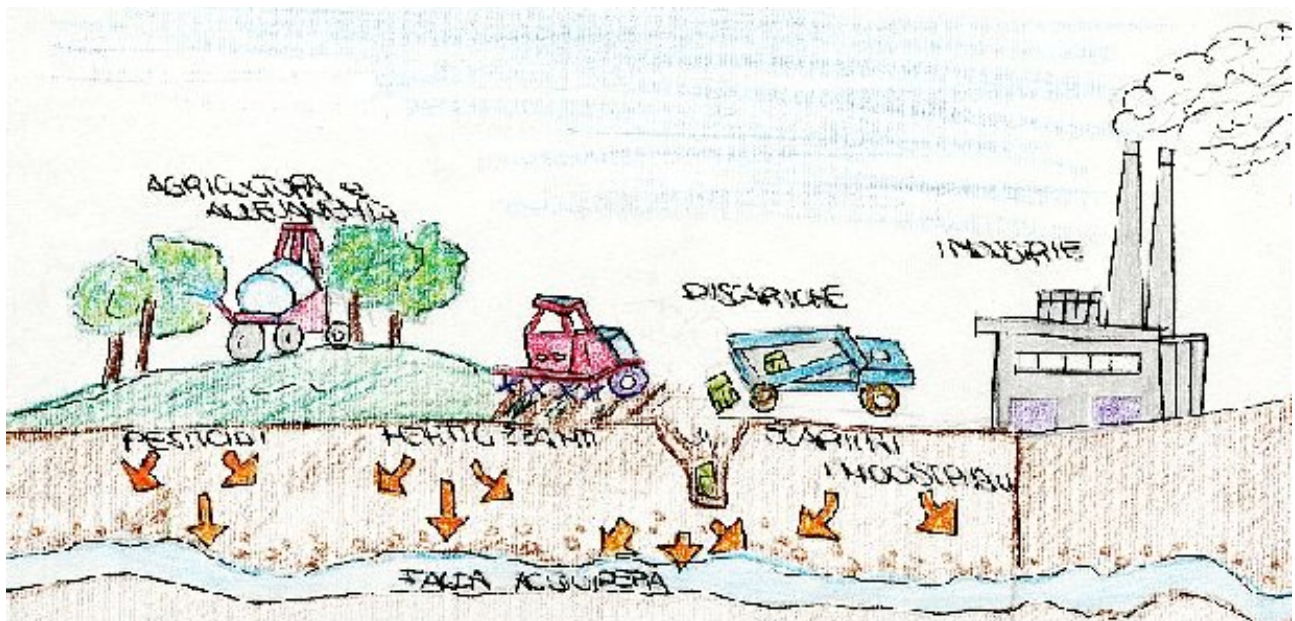

*Nations spend a great deal of money trying to clean up their rivers and lakes. Is this investment really worth it? How do we know if we under- or over-spend? This seminar explores this question empirically in a smaller agricultural watershed, using a newly developed analytic tool (InVEST, from the Natural Capital Project by the University of Minnesota and others) that permits us to think about the extent to which water quality investments are, or are not, rationally supported by Science.*
